February 23, 2012</p> <p>6:00-9:00 p.m.</p> <p>Teacher: Paula McCoy</p> <p>Class Fee: \$55.00</p>		<p>Dragonfly Glass Bowl: Create this 8" square glass bowl using Colors for Earth BubbleART glass colors along with piping paste, dichro bits, colored frit and opaque spirit glass pieces.</p> <p>Supplies: All glass, Thin Fire paper and use of colors, brushes and detailed paperwork with photos are included in class fee. Glass saggars are available for purchase at 20% off with class purchase.</p>

Students should bring a take home box and small fan for drying products.</p>

Beginner brushstrokes, layering of colors and how to create solid coverage with translucent underglazes.</p> <p>Supplies: Bisque, color, brushes provided in class. Students should bring a take home box and small fan for drying products.</p>

This technique includes tinting Relief Motif and shading for a texture build up on this floral design.</p> <p>Supplies: Students will have choice of egg or bunny. If you choose the egg with hinged gold ring it is sold separately. Students will receive bisque, use of brushes and color in class along with step by step paperwork and colored photos. Students should bring a take home box and small fan for drying products.</p>

This technique includes basic glass color application, shading, texture build up with frit, paste and Relief Motif along with controlled bubbles with BubbleART colors.</p> <p>Supplies: Students will receive 2-6"x6" Clear glass, color, frit and brushes provided in class. Students should bring a take home box.</p>

Color decoration is done with Colors For Earth Color Concentrates and Color Strokes. This piece has color layering, sponging, brushstrokes and a decorative sponging technique for a different background look.</p> <p>Supplies: 1-Bisque planter, color, brushes provided in class. Students should bring a take home box and small fan for drying products.</p>

This technique includes piping, layering colors, shading and beginner brushstrokes. There are 3 different colored dragonflies around the vase.</p> <p>Supplies: Students will receive bisque, use of brushes and color in class along with step by step paperwork and colored photos. Students should bring a take home box and #6 square shader and small sumi brush if you have one, if not we will have some for use in class.</p>
<p>Saturday, Feb. 25, 2012</p> <p>1-4 p.m.</p> <p>Teacher: Helen Daum</p> <p>Class Fee: \$45.00</p>		<p>Dogwood or Magnolia Clay Flower/Box: Create clay dogwood flower and bud with leaves attached to this round greenware box. Learn how to create a textured finish to outside of box also.</p> <p>Supplies: Students will receive greenware box, flower cutters, flower making book (over 20 flowers included), latex leaf veiner and detailed instructions and color photos. Students should bring a take home box with shredded paper and an old round brush for attaching clay.</p>
