**Glass Class** — Work with Colors for Earth fired glass colors to create this 8 inch square plate. This design also features the use of 96 COE Pebbles and “Relief Motif” on glass. Relief Motif has a firing range from cone 015 to 6 high-fire.

Students will receive detailed instructions and photos, the use of color and brushes with workshop fee. Student should bring take home box. Students are responsible for firing at home. Class Fee: \$55

**Black Elegance** — This piece features Colors for Earth new “Black Matt” glaze and “Relief Motif” products. Create this elegant majolica piece with scroll work design with Paula McCoy. Have you always wanted a black background with bright colors for the design work, if so we have the technique for you? No more masking off and painting around designs. Students will work on black matt glaze base using Color Strokes for design work and accent with Relief Motif. Relief Motif is a stand-up white textured glaze that can be tinted. Relief Motif covers in one coat or can be built up for designs.

Student will complete one piece and receive detailed instructions with photos, the use of color and brushes with workshop fee. Pieces may vary. Student should bring take home box (8x8). Students are responsible for firing at home. Class Fee: \$45

**Daisy Relief** — Create this vase that features our NEW “Designer Lava Stone” Glaze as well as underglazes and “Relief Motif” by Colors for Earth. Learn how to combine underglazes, glazes along with creating a design that is raised. Relief Motif is a stand-up white textured glaze that can be tinted, covers in one coat and can be built up for designs.

Students will learn how to apply the Relief Motif over glazes and create floral designs along with brush stroke leaves and shading. Students will receive detailed instructions with step-by-step photos, use of color and brushes with workshop fee. Students will receive a #2 filbert and a 1 ounce jar of Relief Motif with workshop fee.

**Welcome Sign** — Learn to hand-build “Welcome Sign” using clay with Renee Gehman. Work with portable slab table, extruder, pottery tools and texture stamps. Decorate your sign with simple hand built creations, or using a variety of press molds. Use of all tools, clay, molds and other supplies included in workshop fee.

Student should bring a take home box (12x12) with shredded paper to transport item home. A printed copy of detailed instructions with photos will be given as part of the workshop fee so you can recreate another piece at home or teach in your studio. Class Fee: \$40

**Peacock Vines** — Work with translucent underglazes to create this colorful plate. Color decoration is done on soft-fired ware with Colors for Earth Color Concentrates. You will learn basic brushstrokes, scroll work background and layering of colors techniques.

Students will receive detailed instructions and photos, the use of color and brushes with workshop fee. Students will receive a #6 square shader with workshop fee.

Student should bring take home box. Students are responsible for firing to bisque, glazing and firing. Class Fee: \$45

Students will learn how to tint the Relief Motif and create floral designs along with brush stroke leaves and shading. Students will receive gold hinge to finish their box, detailed instructions for 4 different designs with step-by-step photos, use of color and brushes with workshop fee.
