Translucent Underglaze: [*Fire Color Used Under A Glaze*] Color pigments that are applied to ware to add details of color. [1] Effect is translucent versus opaque as in an engobe. [2] A wide array of applications and specialty techniques can be achieved.

CFE Color Concentrates: [*Pure Firing Pigment*] A fired blend of metal and ceramic oxides that have been ground into a fine powder suspended in a non-degrading pure gel base, then ball milled for consistency. This process produces a ready to use fired color pigment, we refer to as Color Concentrates.

What can you do with Color Concentrates?

Straight from the bottle, Color Concentrate is a Translucent Underglaze, and can be used in any technique that calls for a translucent underglaze.

- As a translucent one-stroke on greenware or bisque
- 3 or more coats can be applied for solid coverage to block in patterns on greenware or bisque.
- Airbrushing (slightly thinned, no straining)
- Can be used for antiquing on bisque.
- Finger painting or hand printing on bisque.
- Bubble painting
- Use to color any of the CFE Product Enhancers.

Color Concentrates Are Simply Bright and Pure Hydrated Fired Color Pigments ready for you to adapt in a moment to your project needs.

The Colors for Earth system which includes a selection of base mediums allows you to blend many products to create many effects and colors. All products are totally compatible; following blending guidelines.

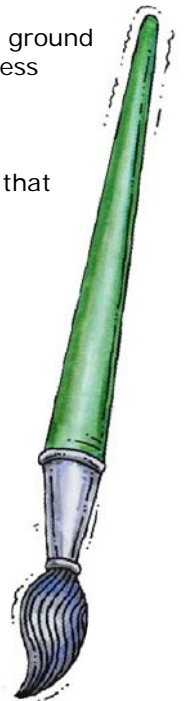
Think Color First.. Then Enhance The Color To Meet Your Application Needs. By adding CFE product enhancers (base mediums) to any color concentrate you can make many types of fired products in an array of colors on your palette or blend a batch.

Artist Quality, Beginner Easy. The CFE color system is the simplest way to really learn about decorating with fired colored.

Standard Packaging is 1 and 2 ounce squeeze bottles. Pints and Gallons are available.

NOTE: Because firing pigments are made from natural oxides they have thixotropic properties. Color Concentrates will liquefy upon shaking.

There are cases, with some of the pigment colors that a few drops of water can be added to the shaker bottle to aid in process of moving the pigment back and forth in the shaker bottle to liquefy the pigment for use.

Opaque clay based underglazes for bisque or greenware.

Translucent underglaze for bisque or greenware.

Transparent gloss glaze.

Semi-opaque gloss glaze.

Matt glazes (Solids or Specks)
