



# Application Technique

## Banding With Out A Wheel



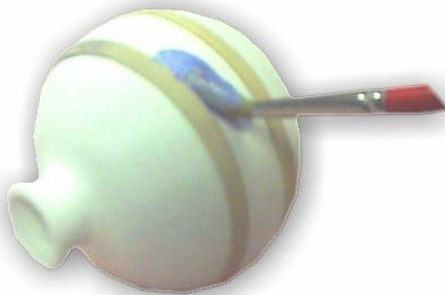
This simple and easy application technique is perfect substitute for a banding wheel when you need a straight edge band of color. Also Class Room situations when you do not have 15 to 20 banding wheels.

### **Supplies:**

Rubber Bands  
Wooden Skewers (grocery store)

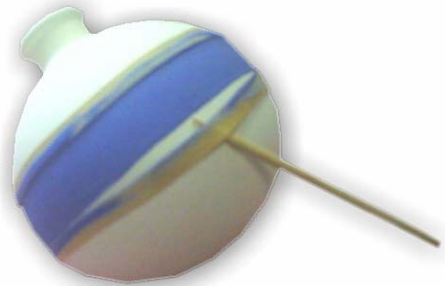
### **Photo 1:**

Place rubber bands around the shape at a distance apart that you would like your colored band. The tip of the wooden skewer can be of assistance here to move the rubber band exactly into place.



### **Photo 2:**

Apply your color. We are working on bisque.. Greenware is too fragile for the rubber band banding technique.



### **Photo 3:**

After color has dried use the tip of the paint skewer to lift up the band and pull away from the bisque.

Hint... make sure the color has dried on the rubber band... or use a cotton swab to remove any wet color from the band before removing the rubber band from the bisque to avoid accidents of smeared color.
